Re: Temporary Closure

To all our employees, guests, and partners,

As of 5:00P today, we will temporarily close our business to the community. Our management team has just been made aware that there have been two team members at our facility that have tested positive for COVID-19 in the recent days and we feel it is best to take all the precautions we can to ensure everyone's safety. As a business, and more importantly as a family, we want to make sure we are doing our part to keep our entire community safe.

Understanding that there is an inherent risk in returning from social distancing while in a pandemic, we also understand that we are a part of a societal decision that accepts balancing COVID-19 risk against the need for life to resume to a sense of normalcy. As such, we will require/perform the following before our planned reopening on July 10, 2020:

- Our entire team will be required to conduct a mandatory test for COVID-19 and produce those results prior to returning to work. Should any employee test positive prior to returning, there will be a mandatory quarantining for 14 days and the need to be re-tested with a negative result prior to returning to work,
- Ichiban Cleaning Service will continue to clean and sanitize the building while we are closed,
- We will engage a consultant to evaluate our efforts and procedures to discuss whether there are any improvements that can be made,

As evidenced by this decision, the safety of our community, our team, and our partners is of the highest priority. This decision to temporarily close was made solely by our management team with everyone's best interests in mind. Our reopening date is currently set for Friday July 10, 2020 however, this date will remain fluid based on our ability to perform the tasks listed above and upon evaluation of the COVID-19 status in the community.
